In the 1890s there were numerous factories hidden behind the terraces of Southgate Road but The Millinery Works is one of the few remaining examples.

The factory was sensitively remodelled, restored and converted in 1996 in a project that retained much of the integrity and detail of the original factory.

The space now offers a light filled gallery of fine art and an extensive display of original Arts and Crafts furniture. Both the building and the furniture it contains reflect the period when the Arts and Crafts movement, inspired by John Ruskin and William Morris, was laying the foundations of modernist design in Europe.

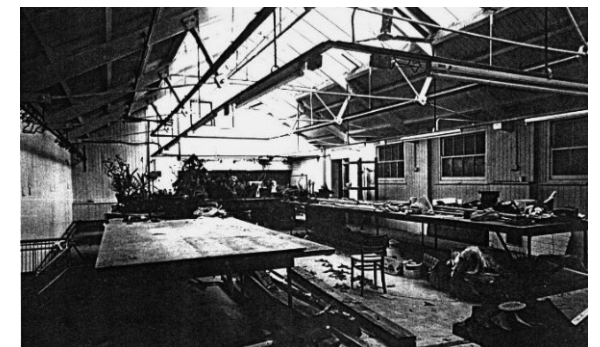
